2:45-3:45pm: Unguided tours of **Studebaker National Museum**. Three floors all accessible by elevator.

"View 114 years of automotive history, from the family's Conestoga Wagon to the last car to roll off the assembly line. Studebaker was the only company to span the time from settlers' wagons to high performance automobiles." You won't want to miss this! (Small refreshment area in lobby).
